

Structure of Bob Minor

It is mostly plain hunt! 65324 COURSING ORDER

Plain Hunt on six bells

12 "changes" Showing the tracks of two of the bells

Each row is a striking sequence of the bells. The red line is the track of the treble (bell No.1).

Bell 5 is shown in blue. Bells 2, 3, 4 & 5 also follow a plain hunt pattern, but with a different starting point.


The pattern shown repeats after 12 changes, and has to be modified to become a ringing "method" in order to produce different rows.






What are dodges?

Help I'm Lost! (Treble passing places)

- Lead in the right place (use your course bells)
 Spot the treble hunting out
 - Pass the treble in 5-6, dodge 3-4 down Pass the treble in 4-5, dodge 5-6 down Pass the treble in 3-4, dodge 5-6 up Pass the treble in 2-3, dodge 3-4 up Pass the treble in 1-2, make 2nds


What is really happening at a bob

Place bells:

Run in = 2nds place bell

Run out = 3rds place bell

Make it = 4ths place bell



Plain Bob Minor

What is really happening at a bob

3 Makes the bob 6 5 3 2 4 6 5 2 4 3



But Bobs will only get you so far

- How many changes possible = 6! 6x5x4x3x2x1
- But Bobs can only generate 360




Watching the treble

The treble hunts to 4ths

You dodge each time in 5/6

You dodge each time in 3/4 *Except when the treble is there

Make seconds over the treble



What to do at Bob!

Run out, Run in and Make it

But what then...

Watch the treble and remember the exception!

Little Bob Minor HL=X.16.X.14(12)(14)(1234) <-B BOB <-W 235

Little Bob will only get you so far!

How many changes are possible?

720's are IMPOSSIBLE
